 - Itemized listing of each product including quantity, product description, manufacturer, model number and price;
 - Installation Date (if by contractor) or date of purchase;
 - When including labor must include contractor name, address, phone and license number.
- Only labor performed by a licensed electrical contractor will be considered for rebate. See reverse side for additional details.
- Equipment must meet eligibility requirements. See reverse side for additional details.
- Rebate application must be received within 90 days of purchase or contractor invoice date.
- Commercial Lighting rebates not to exceed \$10,000 per TDPUD account.
- Rebate not to exceed the cost of qualifying equipment and labor.
- Customer agrees to allow verification of equipment installed and estimated savings by an authorized District representative if requested.

TDPUD Commercial Energy Efficiency Rebate Program

The TDPUD Commercial Energy Efficiency Rebate program provides incentives to commercial electric customers for installing high efficiency lighting and other energy efficient plant equipment.

Eligible Equipment and Rebate Amounts

Existing Equipment	Proposed New Equipment	Rebate
≥ 32W linear fluorescent	Reduced wattage (less than or equal to 28W) T8 fluorescent, T8 LED or LED troffer	1/3 of project cost†
250 W or 400 W Metal Halide	Hi-intensity Fluorescent or LED	1/3 of project cost†
Custom: Energy efficient lighting retrofits not included in the above categories including sensors and controls and other energy efficient plant equipment. Contact TDPUD prior to project for details 530.582.3921		\$.16/KWH projected first year savings

- All equipment must be new.
- Reduced wattage T8 fluorescents as defined by CEE specifications <https://library.cee1.org/content/cee-t8-replacement-lamp-specification/>
- T8 LED and other LED technology meeting Energy Star, DesignLights Consortium or equivalent specifications.
- All equipment must operate for a minimum of 5 years.

Additional Program Rules & Information

- Complete the application on the reverse side with Pre and Post retrofit information.
- Attach dated receipt/invoice with required information as noted on reverse side.
- † Project cost includes cost of equipment (lighting equipment, lamps, and other electrical equipment necessary for the retrofit of existing lighting) and labor required for the retrofit. All costs are after any rebate or discount offered by manufacturer, other agency/organization or contractor.
- Only labor performed by a licensed electrical contractor will be considered for rebate.
- Equipment and labor required to bring a facility up to code or for other electrical services will not be included in calculating the rebate amount. If other equipment and labor are included in project, it must be shown separately on the invoice.
- This rebate is only for the retrofit of existing lighting or electric plant equipment. New construction and additions are not eligible unless they exceed Title 24 requirements. Contact TDPUD for details, 530.582.3921.
- Custom projects must be approved by TDPUD prior to installation of equipment.
