

Where Our Power Comes From

The District purchases its energy through bilateral contracts with entities outside the Truckee area. Power is brought to the District's four substations and one metering point over Sierra Pacific Power Company's transmission system. It is then distributed over the District's fifteen individual circuits to approximately 12,100 electric customers.

Electric Service Territory

The District serves electric customers in the downtown Truckee area, Gateway, Meadow Park, the Armstrong and Biltz Tracts, Donner Lake, Tahoe Donner, Sierra Meadows, Ponderosa Palisades, Ponderosa Ranchos, Prosser Heights, Prosser Lakeview, Sugar Pine Estates, Olympic Heights and portions of Glenshire. Sierra Pacific Power Company and Pacific Gas and Electric serve surrounding areas.
