**Question #1:** What is the total amount of final edited deliverables and/or hours per month that the TDPUD is looking to contract for

**Answer #1:** Requested contract services will vary from month-to-month dependent on need, including events, field work scheduled, campaigns, etc. The annual budgeted cost for this contract for 2026 is not to exceed \$30,000.

**Question #2:** I see that location/history with the region is 80 percent of your criteria for awarding this contract. Do you think an LA-based company would have a shot at this or should I not pursue it?

**Answer #2:** Experience working with local Truckee-Tahoe businesses and agencies accounts for 20% of the selection criteria. Please refer to Section 6.0 in the RFP for the list of criteria that makes up the other 80% of the proposal evaluation. TDPUD also has a Local Preference Procurement Policy, which can be found in Section 6.1.

All proposals will be evaluated on the selection criteria and proposal requirements set forth in the RFP.

**Question #3:**

1. What types of projects do you anticipate most frequently in 2026 (e.g., utility work, events, field documentation)?
2. Does the District have a separate budget for the additional requested services detailed under section 4.2 of the RFP?
3. How far in advance does the District typically arrange these on-call services?
4. Does the District have a current provider for these services? If so, is the District satisfied with the current level of service?
5. Do shoots typically take place during normal business hours, or will evening/weekend availability be required?
6. For a shoot under section 4.2, how many sit-down interviews would you anticipate?

**Answer #3:**

1. We do not yet know which type of photo/video project we will need services for most frequently in 2026.
2. No, there is not a separate budget for the Additional Requested Services in Section 4.2.
3. We request on-call services anywhere from the day before a project to 2-3 weeks ahead of the time.
4. The District has a consultant contracted for its current Photographer-Videographer Services contract. The scope of this RFP for has been expanded beyond the scope of the District's current Photographer-Videographer Services contract
5. While most shoots take place during normal business hours, we do require weekend and evening services at times.
6. At this time we cannot predict how many sit-down interviews we would require for the type of project mentioned in Section 4.2.
