Equipment & Services Eligibility

1. Leakage tests (otherwise known as "Duct Blasting" or "Blower-Door Testing" measure the "leakiness" of a residence and/or its duct work in Air Changes per Hour (ACH). Testing before and after helps to identify issues and confirm that they are mitigated. Tests are required to qualify for the full rebate(s).
2. Eligible mitigations include weatherstripping, door-strips, window insulation, and wall-plate gaskets.
3. Eligible mitigations include repairs of exterior wall penetrations, repairs to leaky ductwork, or other issues identified via envelope and/or duct leakage tests. Eligible for 100% of costs (up to \$1,000) with pre- and post- leakage tests to confirm effectiveness of mitigations.
4. Must improving existing attic insulation to $\geq$ R-44, wall insulation to $>$ R-13 (for 2x4 wall construction) or $>$ R-19 (for 2x6 wall construction), and floor insulation to $\geq$ R-25. Limit of \$1,000 incentive combined for all insulation projects.
5. Existing windows must be single pane or (if dual pane) over 20 years old.
6. New windows must be National Fenestration Rating Council (NFRC) rated with proof of this provided and have a U-value <0.3 .

Program Terms

- Services performed more than 90 days prior to application are not eligible.
- Applicant must be a current electric or water customer with an active TDPUD account to be eligible for rebates.
- Application must include detailed and dated sales receipt(s), eligible equipment or service(s) clearly identified.
- Application must include contractor invoice, with contractor name, address and license number clearly identified.
- Application must include photos of newly installed windows, building envelope and/or central air distribution mitigation and repairs, as appropriate.
- Rebates are issued to the account holder as a one-time credit or check if rebate amount is great than \$700.00, to active TDPUD account. Credits are typically applied within 6-8 weeks of TDPUD receiving the application.
- If account holder is a landlord and account is inactive at the time of rebate issuance, a check will be mailed to the address on file.
- Rebates are limited to (1) rebate type per account.
- Rebates for miscellaneous weatherization measures are eligible once annually.
- Rebate not to exceed the cost of equipment, parts, services and professional labor provided and sales tax is not included.
- Customer agrees to allow verification of installation by an authorized District representative if requested.
- "Before" photo of item(s) in place must be submitted with rebate application clearly showing damage or original condition..
- "After" photo of new installed item(s) must be submitted with rebate application showing repairs performed.
- A detailed estimate and invoice for windows is required, including specific size and dimensions of each window and parts and labor listed separately..
- This rebate application must be signed and dated on the second page of this document.
