### Product Eligibility

- Evidence of leak must be visible in Smarthub and verified by TDPUD staff.
- Application must be submitted within 90 days from date of leak repair to be eligible for a rebate.
- Repairs must be completed by homeowner or a licensed professional.
- Leak rebates are available per leak while project funds are available.
- New construction projects are not eligible for a water leak rebate.

### Program Terms & Conditions

- Applicant must be a current water customer with an active TDPUD account to be eligible for water rebates.
- Application must include detailed and dated sales receipt(s) with products and or service(s) clearly identified, including contractor's name.
- Rebates are issued to the account holder as a one-time water credit. Payments are typically applied within 6-8 weeks of TDPUD receiving the application.
- If account holder is a landlord and account is inactive at the time of rebate issuance, a check will be mailed to the landlord address on file.
- Rebate amount not to exceed cost of repairs up to a maximum of \$300.00.
- Sales tax does not qualify for rebate incentive.
- Photo or copy of building permits must be provided if applicable.
- 'Before' and 'after' photos of project required if applicable.
- TDPUD staff must be able to verify that there was an initial leak and that the leak has been repaired<sup>1</sup>.
- Application must be signed, dated, and contain all supporting documentation.

TDPUD disclaims all liability from taxes incurred or any property damage or loss that may arise as a result of the applicant's participation in this program. The rebate offer may be discontinued or modified at any time by TDPUD. Applicant certifies that the above noted appliances(s) and or equipment will be installed at the TDPUD service address identified on this application. I have read, understand and agree to abide by the program rules, requirements and terms & conditions. I certify that the information provided on this application and associated required documentation is true and correct.
